

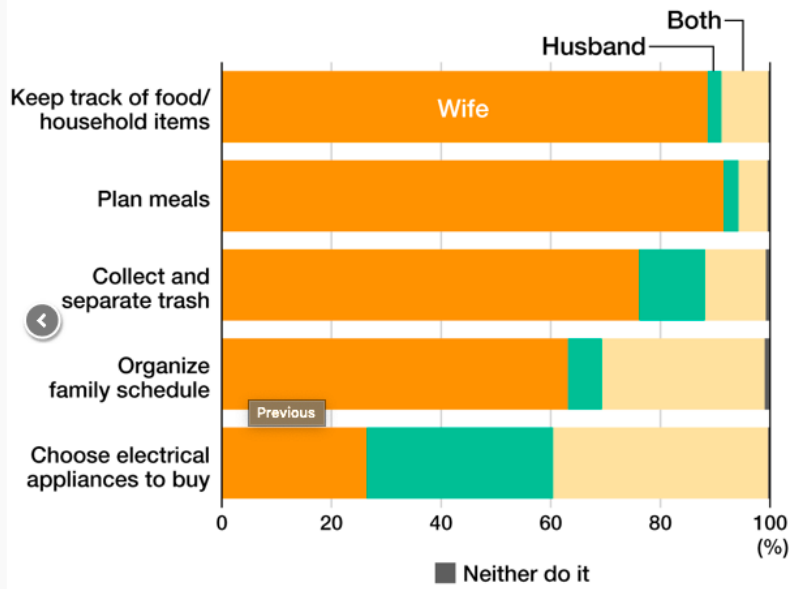

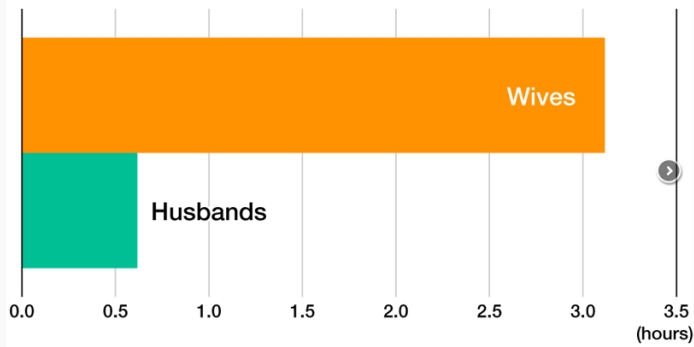
Who Performs “Invisible” Housework?

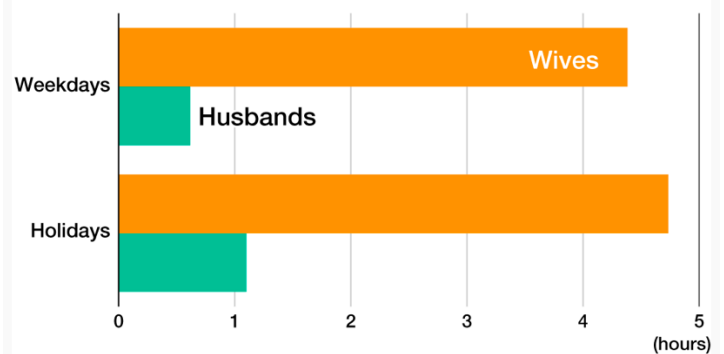
Average Time Spent by Working Wives and Husbands on Housework (Weekdays)
